Birth	Hep B
1 mo	Hep B
2 mo	HIB, Pc, DTaP, Rotavirus, Polio
4 mo	HIB, Pc DTaP, Rotavirus, Polio
6 mo	HIB, Pc, DTaP, Rotavirus, Hep B, Flu
9 mo	Hgb (anemia screen)
1 yr	MMR, Chickenpox, Hep A
15 mo	DTaP, HIB, Pc,
18 mo	Hep A, Flu, Flouride treatment, M chat (developmental screening)
2 yr	Flouride
3 yr	Vision screening
4 yr	DTaP, Polio, MMR, Chickenpox, vision screening
5 yr	Vision/hearing screen
6-18yrs	Check up, vision annually (Chickenpox 5-18 yrs if not given at age 4) (Tdap 10-18 yrs) (Meningococcal 11-18 yrs) (HPV 12-18 yrs)
